




Dear Friends in Christ

SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL VOTER'S MEETING

As we re-open Redeemer Lutheran Church, we will be holding a Special Voters Meeting **this Sunday**, June 28, at **12:00 p.m.** in the Sanctuary

Redeemer's Leadership Board met and unanimously approved the recommendation that we move forward toward Calling an Intentional Interim Pastor. The next step is to bring that to the congregation in a special voter's meeting for approval.

Agenda Items Will Include:

- -Vacancy Pastor versus Calling an Intentional Interim Pastor
- -Federal Care Act Loan application
- -Motion to move forward with Intentional Interim or Vacancy Pastor
- -Motion to Approve Congregation Constitutional Bylaws change to allow women to serve all positions on our Leadership Board (as brought forward in our previous Voter's Meeting)

Here are a few things that will look a little different for a season, at Redeemer:

- When entering the building, please find your seat in the sanctuary and remember to remain socially distanced (6 feet between family units).
- The order of service will be similar to what you've experienced on the pre-recorded services.
- There will be liturgy and music, but no congregational singing.
- Pew Bibles will not be available for a season, please bring your Bible from home.
- We strongly encourage the wearing of masks while in the building.
- An usher will escort one family/couple/individual at a time out for communion. You are welcome to leave your masks in your pew as you are released for communion.
- Unused rooms in the building will be closed to the public, including the nursery (changing stations are available in the women's restrooms).
- At dismissal an usher will let you out by family/couple/individual beginning at the front of the sanctuary please exit the building as quickly as possible so the sanctuary can be sanitized and set for the next service.
